MANSUET LE JEUNE - Critical and apologetic history of the order of the knights of the temple of Jerusalem, known as templars. Paris, Chez Guillot, 1789; in-4, color frontispiece, XV, a fold-out map representing the Holy Land, 390, 364 pp., contemporary full speckled calfskin binding, spine decorated with five-ribbed poppies, edges painted in red, title label in morocco red. We know from Dom Calmet in the "Lorraine Library" that the author was a professor of philosophy and theology at Pont-à-Mousson from 1732 to 1739, then he was a professor at the abbey of Etival. His history of the Templars obviously speaks of the Templars in Lorraine. Rare and complete work of the frontispiece in color.
