Delphin Enjolras 1847-1945: academic painter of portraits, nudes and interiors, he studied at the School of Drawing of the City of Paris under the direction of the watercolourist Gasson Gerard, he also studied at the Academy des Beaux-Arts in Paris under the direction of famous masters and artists, Jean-Léon Gérôme
