



## 19th Bronze Bust Of Ariane F Barbedienne



## Description

A French patinated bronze bust of Ariadne by F. Barbedienne, exemplifying the masterful craftsmanship and artistry of the 19th century. The piece, known for its exquisite "parcel reduction" technique, draws inspiration from the classical sculptures of Bertel Thorvaldsen, circa 1805-1810. This bust is often compared to the renowned antique bust of Antinous, currently housed in the Fitzwilliam Museum, due to its similar execution and emotional depth. Ariadne, in Greek mythology, was the daughter of King Minos and played a pivotal role in aiding the hero Theseus with her thread to navigate the

abyrinth and escape the Minotaur. As a symbol of resilience and personal growth, her figure has come to represent the strength and courage required to overcome great challenges.
