Rare and beautiful earthenware vase of architectural shape composed of a circular belly with flattened faces, on a base and collar with a recess, the decoration painted under cover in a narrow range of colors represents an elegant young woman wearing perfume height 26 cm length 21 cm width 7 cm Signature molded under the base Robert Lallemand (1902-1954) Work around 1925 Robert Lallemand's works remain rare due to the low production of French ceramist decorator and photographer who knew how to invent a new architectural ceramic He settled in a workshop bought by his father in the 3rd arrondissement of Paris and will stop producing in 1930 to devote himself only to decoration and photography See the work of Madame du Pasquier Somogy editions for more information:
