### Description

Large sculpture by Louis-Emile Cana (1845-1895) artist who exhibited at the Universal Exhibition in 1878. Pupil of Arson, he gives us here a bucolic work, presenting a young girl carrying a basket full of cherries. Dressed in a spring outfit and her soft hair wrapped in a scarf, she sits on a stump, barefoot and sports a slight smile that illuminates her youthful features. The details brought to this sculpture and the softness which emerges from it illustrate the innocence, the beauty and the poetry of youth. \*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*
