Description

The broad-shouldered tapered body, forged in one piece, rests on a narrow supporting plinth, with a rolled base. Chunky collar fitted with a rolled edge. Short bridged bottle. Hinged lid, domiform with flat and socket. Fixed side flat handle, decorated, as well as the bridging arm, with repetitive stamped motifs. The shoulder around the base of the collar has an amati and punched decoration of a decalobated collar with the sacramental formula in capital letters: DOMINE SALVUM FAC REGEM NOSTRUM LUDO VICUM: "God save our King Louis". It is a public prayer for the king, which began with these words and was sung on Sundays in all the churches of the kingdom. This life-saving antiphon took on particular importance in August 1744, when Louis XV fell seriously ill following

overeating, aggravated by sunburn... France, at this news, became as if distraught with grief. The old monarchical idolatry awoke. The king eventually recovered, and was henceforth nicknamed "Louis the Beloved", before sinking thereafter into the vilest debauchery and dying hated by all.
