He enrolled at the Beaux-Arts in his hometown and then in 1921, at those of Paris where he was a pupil of Jean Boucher and Despiau. Very influenced by Maillol, he first practiced direct carving on wood and stone. He exhibited from 1923 at the Salon des Artistes Français. He received the gold medal in 1937 at the International Exhibition in Paris. Knight of the Legion of Honor in 1950 Died in 1988.
