



Old "family Pharmacy" Case, Mid 19th Century



Description

Old case "Pharmacie des familles" of the Pharmacie Normale, J. Guettrot, 15 Rue Drouot in Paris. Middle of the XIXth century. The wooden case is covered with a paper imitating leather, in the state with detachments, tears and lacks. The interior is compartmentalized and lined with velvet.

This pharmacy kit includes:

- 10 square section glass vials, most with labels and still containing their product inside (8 vials 11.5 cm high and 2 vials 8 cm high);

- 7 cylindrical glass bottles with pouring spouts (burettes) and heart-shaped stoppers (height 10 cm);

- 1 very small glass bottle with a round stopper (height 5.5 cm)

- 4 hexagonal bottles in yellow tinted glass with
