This young woman is represented in a 17th century costume whose dress ends in a lace collar. This lady of quality has her hair up in a bun and wears a tiara and a pair of earrings and a necklace. The frame is finely chiseled, hemmed with a black enamel net and set with fine half-pearls. Gold hallmark: eagle head. 18 karat.
