

Sterling Silver And Crystal Table Vinegar In Nineteenth Overlay

A pretty solid silver vinegar maker From the 19th century but in the style of the 18th century For the corks, among other things... By the goldsmiths DEBAIN & FLAMANT in PARIS And crystal from SAINT LOUIS Blown crystal cut as an overlay and applied handles. The overlay is a deep royal blue... With a beautiful gold-painted enamel With a different decor for each decanter but a reminder with LOUIS XVI knots Which has only a few weares... The bottoms of the decanters are not veiled... Just a little "light" soiling...! Note a crack on a handle at the level of a low attachment... in the manufacture.. Even if on the photo it was important it is not the case...! Because I have often seen this problem on certain vinegar jugs... Otherwise, no problem with the solid silver
