- Polychrome porcelain group from the Meissen porcelain factory located in Saxony in Germany representing a pastoral scene. - The leaning gentleman with a bouquet of leafy flowers in his left hand holding a flower with its foliage in his right hand. - The seated shepherdess playing the mandolin with a sheep lying at her feet with a flowering and leafy tree. - Gold edging at the base of the base. - Model created by Joachim Kandeler. - Intaglio engraved mold number 447 and intaglio number 23. - Signed with the stamp of the Meissen porcelain factory of the two crossed swords in underglaze blue. - Period 4th quarter of the 19th century around 1875-1885.
