Specialized in working with gold, modernizing the ancient art of chrysotechnics, a unique technique of hammering gold, he is inspired by Greek cultural heritage and Hellenistic art and adopts the

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symbols of ancient architecture like the lions of Mycenae, the rams, the eagle, the sphynx, etc...

His son Xenophon Zolotas, in the second half of the 20th century, forged partnerships with Greek museums, to study and be inspired by jewelry ancient. He counts among his clients Liz Taylor, Jackie Onassis or Romy Schneider...
