Perfect condition, except for a cooking crack at the heel, practically invisible (see photo)

"Jean Rivier is an autodidact in the arts (painting, drawing , photo).

Born in Tunis, arrived in France as a child, he was first an apprentice watchmaker and jeweler while being a poet-writer.

In 1946, he trained as a ceramist with Emilie Decanis in Aix en Provence.

In 1952, he moved to Vallauris and welcomed French and foreign trainees in his studio, such as

The couple worked together until their separation in 1961.
