Small enamelled ceramic bowl by Jean Rivier (1915 - 2017) Circa 1960 Vallauris Signature under the heel Perfect condition, except for a cooking crack at the heel, practically invisible (see photo)

"Jean Rivier is an autodidact in the arts (painting, drawing, photo).

Born in Tunis, arrived in France as a child, he was first an apprentice watchmaker and jeweler while being a poet-writer. In 1946, he trained as a ceramist with Emilie

Decanis in Aix en Provence.

In 1952, he moved to Vallauris and welcomed

French and foreign trainees in his studio, such as
