Sterling silver jug by Denys Frankson received in 1765-1791 Denys Frankson's master goldsmith hallmark: a crosier, two points, a crowned fleur-de-lys. Release hallmark: a sheet with the number 4 for 1787. Hallmark of the community of goldsmiths of Paris under the management of Henri Clavel for works in 958 thousandth silver. punches on the bottom, in the lid and on the edge of the jug. A few pods, blackened wooden handle (no screwing on the left) Weight: 0.710 kg without the handle. Reference: Beuque and Frapsauce
