

Amazing Scatological Snuffbox In Trompe l'Oeil, Nineteenth Century Paper Mache, Napo



Description

Very surprising and curious papier-mâché snuffbox forming a trompe l'oeil excrement, dating from the end of the 19th century.

This snuffbox takes the form of a naturalistic excrement with, below, a compartment to store the tobacco. The latter closing with a hinged lid decorated with a radiating pattern.

The set is made of papier-mâché painted in trompe l'oeil.

The association between tobacco and scatology has existed for a long time, notably with the famous boxwood snuffboxes known as "father the colic". These papier-mâché snuffboxes, although more modest in their production, are now much
