Description

Prosper Lecourtier, chiseled and gilded bronze jewelry box representing a cushion lined with trimmings surmounted by a chiseled and silvered bronze dog on a red marble base. Signed P Lecourtier. In a perfect state. Bibliography: Prosper Lecourtier was a pupil of Emmanuel Frémiet (1824-1910) and he exhibited at the Paris Salon from 1875 until his death in 1925. Frémiet seems to have bequeathed his passion for the animal world to his pupil. The latter excelled in the production of animals in a naturalistic style². Lecourtier meanwhile expressed his talent through sculptures of more modest dimensions. We find in his sculptures of hunting scenes the influence of his master, however Lecourtier stands out from his model by the integration of movement as shown by his sculptures of hunting
