Beautiful reproduction on paper of a wood engraving by Albrecht DÜRER (1471-1528) Representing SAINT JEROME in his room around 1491, Saint Jerome who holds by the paw a small lion.

This work by DÜRER was first published in the *Epistolare Beati Hieronymi* (Nicolas Kessler)

Nicolaus Kesler: Basilea, August 8, 1492.

This woodcut is the oldest known work of Albrecht DÜRER.
