Superb pair of molded and flowered oak woodwork doors from the 17th Louis XIV period Typical doors from the early Louis which still have a very strong influence from the Louis XIII period The central panels are double molded as is customary at that time The so-called "gendarme hat" movement is superbly made at the top and bottom which is very rare The lock works with its key but it is from the early 19th century Set of exceptional quality h: 182.2 cm width of door 1: 63.3 cm width of door 2 (with its frame): 71.6 cm total width: 134.9 cm depth: 3.9 cm
