

1960s Fils Tourbillon Ring Brilliant Cut Diamonds On Platinum



Description

This platinum ring (dog head hallmark) alone brings together several types of jewelry. Its general shape, flat on the finger and curved, evokes old rings. Similarly, two lines of curved diamonds create the aesthetic of Belle Epoque swirl rings. At the center of this tourbillon, a substantial one-carat prong-set brilliant-cut diamond makes this jewel a solitaire. Finally, between the center and the lines of diamonds, wires arranged in rays give scale to this ring and give it an aesthetic of its time, the 60s. A solitaire ring therefore bringing together both the classic codes and those of 'a unique jewel. Weight of the central diamond estimated at approximately 1.00 ct Total weight of the surrounding diamonds estimated at approximately 0.95 ct Or a total weight of diamonds estimated at 1.95 carats
