Montmartre, at the end of his life in 1945 he lived
at 16 rue du grand prieuré Paris 16th.

His workshop was at 14 bis rue des Minimes,
Paris. Lelievre exhibited at La Société des
Artistes Décorateurs, La Société des Artistes
Français and La Société Nationale des
Beaux-Arts
