Description

Superb two-body sideboard in solid cherry wood from the 18th century, originating from the Charentes. The lower body is made up of 2 doors and a large pull-out called a "breadboard" and an interior shelf. The feet are shell-shaped. The plinth is good. scalloped with the same decoration as the doors The sides are scalloped like the front plinth Usual restorations: rear legs rehent The doors have a beautiful Louis XV scroll molding which recalls the shell of the feet The upper body has a shelf interior and 2 molded doors like those at the bottom The upper transom is decorated with a beautiful molding with a beautiful rosette in its center The whole is topped with a pretty cornice The bottom shelf is surrounded by an ogee The uprights are fluted announcing Louis XVI period The locks are original as well as the
