essence of rural life with poignant authenticity.

The 19th century was a time of great social and artistic upheavals, marked by the industrial revolution and the beginnings of modernity. In this context, art often endeavored to capture the reality of the working classes, a subject hitherto rarely represented with such dignity. This drawing exemplifies this trend, highlighting not only the subject matter but also the technical mastery of the draughtsman.

The choice of charcoal, with its potential for rich and deep nuances, underlines the intimate atmosphere of the scene. The relatively modest dimensions of the work (32.2 x 17.8 cm) reinforce its personal and immediate character.

This drawing is a fragment of history and a connection to the everyday life of a bygone era, captured by the hand of an artist with a sensitive gaze and a confident technique.
