very rare pair of large display cups in Paris porcelain brand painted with manganese on the reverse of a Rousseau cup house Rousseau in Paris at 43 rue de la Coquillière sale of porcelain and earthenware later glassworks founded in 1826 by Joseph Rousseau and taken over by his Son Eugène made famous by his collaborations with Félix Bracquemond the Appert house and of course Ernest Leveillé It is rare to find porcelain with the name of the Rousseau house High quality models mid-19th century white and celestial blue background in the style of Sèvres and fine gold highlights openwork top with decoration of acanthus leaves and button in the Louis XVI style in 2 parts the foot is removable corrosion of the metal at the screws 19cm high 26cm in diameter in good condition see the
