

Lapar, Paris, 1897-1925, 950% Sterling Silver, Regency Style Sugar Caster



Description

Very charming sugar or spice caster in sterling silver of the first title (950%). It is closely inspired by the French Regency period casters from Northern France or Flanders with its typical engraved decorations. It bears the master goldsmith's mark of Georges Fouquet Lapar (active 1897-1925)son in law of Léon Lapar (active 1878-1897). There remain traces of gold which must have partially covered it at the beginning of its existence. The caster weighs a very generous 315 grams.
