In 1875, the first small Liberty & Co. store opened its doors on Regent Street, in the West End of London. It became a showcase for cosmopolitan products, and the company became synonymous with exotic, avant-garde design. In particular, Liberty clothing was associated with the Aesthetic movement. Liberty also developed a furniture department, supported by its own workshops, which opened in 1880 under the direction of Leonard F. Wyburd. ...
