Description

Fine quality for this small gilded bronze on a black marble base. The subject is a faun carrying a kid on his shoulders, based on a Roman work. The Roman model for this sculpture is itself a copy of a Hellenistic work now lost. The Roman work (now in the Prado Museum) was discovered in 1675 during an archaeological excavation in Rome. Louis Desprez, who was awarded the Grand Prix de Rome in 1826, was able to reproduce the work during his stay in Italy. It was also carved by Soldani, Clodion, Charles-Jules Inghé, Pierre Lepautre, etc.

Condition: perfect. Note a trace of oxidation on the back.
