Student of Michel Martin Drolling at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, Chaplin works in the purest academic vein, gradually developing his style towards rococo, which is experiencing a revival of interest right in the middle of the 19th century. His paintings often recall the spirit of François Boucher, from whom he draws inspiration for large decorations commissioned by Empress Eugénie in particular.
