Hubert-Denis ETCHEVERRY (Bayonne 1867-Bayonne 1952) "Portrait of a young girl" Oil on oval canvas Signed and dated 1925 top left Silver frame "Le Lys de Provence" L: 46 cm x H: 55.5 cm Hubert- Denis Etcheverry was born in Bayonne on September 21, 1867, and died in his hometown on April 3, 1952. A student of Achille Zo at the municipal drawing school of Bayonne, he was placed first in the school's entrance exam. of fine arts in Paris, where he entered the studio of Léon Bonnat and Albert Maignan. He won a second Rome Prize in 1891 with a painting entitled Jupiter and Mercury received by Philémon and Baucis. He is the author of famous paintings of manners and numerous portraits. In 1913, Etcheverry exhibited Sous le masque, at the Salon des artistes français, the work was
