



## Office Set - Maurice Jallot (1900 - 1971) Post Art Deco



## Description

We present a splendid set that we can attribute to the cabinetmaker Maurice JALLOT (1900 -1971). We found two armchairs similar to ours during the TAJAN sale in Paris, June 12, 2007, lot no. 149 (see catalog photograph). Our set is composed of: a very beautiful light oak desk composed of a left-hand box with 5 drawers on one side and a compartment opening onto a door on the other side of the box, a tray and the all resting on a golden metal base, as are the drawer handles. Format: Height: 74cm - length: 135cm and width 57cm of a pair of light oak armchairs. Spindle feet ending in brass sabots. Slightly recessed armrests. Covered in cognac leather. Format: Height: 91cm - width: 57cm and Depth 58cm. Also a pair of light oak seats. Spindle feet. Covered with green fabric. Height: 88.5cm -
