Terracotta Jar Han Period China (206 BC - 220 AD)

Han dynasty pottery refers to ceramic vessels and figurines produced during the Han dynasty, which lasted from 206 BCE to 220 CE in ancient China. Han Dynasty pottery is renowned for its artistic quality, variety of forms, and technical advancements.

This important jar was used for the preservation of foodstuffs such as wine on the exterior walls, a geometric pattern made by the application of ropes to the surface of the raw clay an embossed relief pattern is applied to both sides of the vase forming handles.

The collar is rolled up and grooved horizontally Very good general condition (no restoration has been made, the object is intact.)
