Description

Silvered bronze mirror from the Han period (206 BC - 220 AD)

The back side of the mirror is decorated with inscriptions on the eccentric circle.

5 lions surrounded by vines are represented in relief on the concentric circle.

The socket is shaped like a half-sphere with a hole in the center.

These mirrors were signs of power and wealth in ancient times up to Japan.

The bronze work of the Han dynasty was of great finesse and the casting techniques were very advanced.

This context makes them precious objects, silvering on bronze was a technique reserved for the finest work for a power elite.
