Important marquise ring whose three main old-cut diamonds dominate a shuttle entirely set with smaller diamonds set in white gold. The yellow gold ring contrasting with the jeweled ring head ends in forked palmettes. A direct witness to 19th century jewelry, this jewel evokes an even older era since this very particular shape comes to us from the 18th century. Indeed, legend has it that King Louis XV was inspired by the smile of his favorite, the Marquise de Pompadour, to create the characteristic shape of this ring.
