Title: six dogs hunting, exhibited at the Rijksmuseum). Etching. Title: Wild boar, deer, heron (exhibited at the Metropolitan Museum and the British Museum). Wenceslas Hollar (1607, Prague - 1677, London) was a designer and engraver from Bohemia. Hollar was, with Abraham Bosse, one of the best engravers of the 17th century, and made the etching technique known in England. He executed a multitude of drawings that are still
