



## Important Neo-renaissance Style Armchair In Solid Walnut, Openwork Carved Ceremonia



## Description

Very important Neo-Renaissance style ceremonial armchair in solid walnut; This majestic seat rests on four legs turned into a baluster and connected together by an H-shaped spacer also turned into a baluster. The two front feet are connected by a richly sculpted and openwork crotch bar; The backrest is very high and framed by two columns ending in two tops at their ends. It is topped with a magnificent, richly carved and openwork pediment. The upholstery is still very comfortable, the covering fabric is an old mechanical tapestry with a braided finish. The whole house is in good condition, however note some old traces of xylophages without impact on the solidity of the structure. Beautiful Neo-Renaissance style workmanship from the second half of the 19th century. Dimensions:
