This beautiful Indo-Persian rug takes up the criteria of ancient Persian decorations, knotted with great finesse and superb quality of Kork wool. Around 1970-1980, we can hardly imagine the immense work to create such a marvel.

The quality of these pieces cannot be demonstrated, the work is fine, precise and durable over time.

The materials used are of the highest quality: fine and soft kork wool, taken from the neck and under the belly of the lambs (first shearing) makes up the velvet knotted on fine cotton for the weft. This rug is clean, the wool is knotted beautifully and finely tight as these rugs always are. It reveals to us shades full of contrasts, many colors, including three blues, two reds, almond green, black and ivory....

A medallion with a deep red field, four spandrels decorated with flowers and branches.

It is surrounded by a border grouping bouquets and large stylized flowers.

Traditional wool rug, comfortable and heavy duty.

The nuances underline this clever floral design in the great tradition of Persian art. Persian art that is also found in Mughal art, inspired by the miniatures of the Tabriz school, then capital of the Persian empire.

## For information: Tabriz (Azerbaijani: Təbriz/تبریز, formerly Tauris), is the capital of the province of East Azerbaijan, in the northwest of Iran (Iranian Azerbaijan).

Tabriz is located on the course of the Talkheh River (also called Aji-Chai), near Lake Urmia, close to the borders of the Republic of Azerbaijan and Armenia. It is the gateway to Persia from north to west, Tabriz carpets are extremely important in the quality of Persian carpets and have a very great international reputation. Tabriz rugs are among the most popular rugs in the world, their work is always very fine and durable over time.
