Description

Important Totem, (ornamental figure probably from the entrance to a priest's dwelling or temple), it is sculpted with a divinity with powerful hands clasped symbolically on the stomach and resting on massive legs. Her neck is covered with a rich necklace and the stylized face, the angular eyebrow arches, present a beautiful, protective and timeless expression. Wood, remains of localized brown patina, gullied by time and bad weather on the lower part, probably buried in the ground. The divinity is in a good general state of conservation, see the photos.
