Porcelain chocolate maker from DELVAUX 18 rue Royale Entirely hand painted Shipping to France 10 euros Perfect condition DELVAUX was a prestigious porcelain and crystal retail store, located at 18 rue Royale in Paris. Founded in the 1880s, it specializes in the sale of everyday art objects: decorated glass, earthenware, porcelain and services from the houses of Haviland, Montigny le Roi, Baccarat, Choisy le Roi, Fontainebleau, Sèvres, Clichy, etc. . The works of famous artists are exhibited and sold: Clément Massier, Félix Optat Milet, Jean Mayodon, Albert Dammouse, Jean Sala, Charles Schneider.... Between 1920 and 1930, Delvaux distributed vases of its brand. A decoration workshop was installed in the store where renowned artists worked there. The signature was

in gold in the decoration or engraved with pontil.

The pieces are all signed with the name of the store and sometimes followed by the address and name of the creator. This boutique will hold its place until the 1970s. Almost a century of existence. These products were particularly well exported to the United States with fun dishes representing the monuments of the city of Paris.

Some summarize the cheeses on a map of France... The signatures bear the name of the store and sometimes the creator with his address.
