Decor on all sides of marquetry, alternating light
and dark woods: patterns geometric, squares and
diamonds. In the center of the cylinder is a large
rectangle with cubic patterns in faux fishnet. Feet
sheathed in blackened wood Ornamentation of an
openwork gallery in gold finish, topped with
pompoms, wonderful work of great
cabinetmaking from the 18th century
