On the obverse: Anepigraph (coin without legend) where the head of Zeus Lycaios (with his laurel wreath) looking to the left stands out. On the reverse: the God Pan is seated on a rock, he raises his right hand while the left holds his lagobolon (stone thrower). We also see an eagle ready to take flight and a triangle which I don't
