The Queens of Persia at the Feet of Alexander is a painting by Charles Le Brun, produced in 1660-1661, which represents Alexander the Great after his victory discovering the queens of Persia in the tent of Darius' family. Oil painting on canvas Work from the end of the 18th century It is a very beautiful subject excellently executed by a member of the artist's entourage Dimensions 47 x 73 cm Frame offered with the work (Recaniled, small restorations) Resumption of the painting by Le Brun kept at the Palace of Versailles.
