Jean Baptiste Victor Barbizet (1808-1884), commonly known as Victor Barbizet, was a French ceramist. He is the founder of the "Parisian School" which is part of the neo-Palissean movement of the 19th century. A merchant from Dijon, he set up his workshop in Paris in 1850, where he still produces ceramics in the Palissy style. In 1858, he obtained the gold
