# The Fountain Of Bacchus, Large Patinated Plaster, End Of The 19th Century



#### Description

Two Fountain Heads representing Bach heads topped with bunches of grapes in plaster from the end of the 19th century.

Superb decorative element from the end of the 19th century representing two bearded men's heads crowned with laurel leaves and grapes with their mouths open in the manner of antique theater masks and forming fountain spouts framed by vines and branches as well as leaves and bunches of grapes.

Bacchus, the god of the vine, Dionysia, Bacchanalia, fauns and satyrs, probably allegorical figures relating to the god Bacchus. A plaster sculpture patinated in the manner of a terracotta.
