- Red leather embossed with the number "H" of Hermann. - The Hohenlohe family has been strongly linked to Spain since the marriage of a prince of the dynasty with the Countess of Belvís, also from a German family, and daughter of a Mexican diplomat. The figure of Alfonso de Hohenlohe, founder of the myth of Marbella in the middle of the century and owner of the Palacio del Quexigal, a magnificent 16th-century Castilian residence, is strongly linked to the post-war beaumonde. The sale of the family home in the mid-1970s by Sotheby's dispersed the family collection. - Dimensions of the object: 45 x 34 cm - From a private collection in Madrid. -Good general condition.
