H 71cm; W 47cm; P 32cm Gaspard Feilt (Died March 30, 1763) - cabinetmaker of German origin, lived in Paris, rue de Charenton in 1753, enjoyed a certain notoriety if we judge by the names of some of the sponsors: the Count of Béthune, the Marshal of Broglie, the Bishop of Autun etc....
