This artist regularly participates in the Salon des Artistes from 1883 to 1905 with statuettes in different materials: Nymphe Chantant, terracotta, 1892, Rêverie, plaster in 1893, marble the following year, Oh! The frog, wax, 1894 - Victorious Amazon, bronze, 1896, Le Corail, tin, 1897, Gladiator, plaster, 1905. He received an
