The agility of the brushstrokes gives the scene the vitality and frenetic movement of a cabaret poster, while the measured lighting evokes the particular aura of the gas street lamps that illuminated Paris in 1900. Opera lovers will not be able to avoid the memory of Musetta's flirtation with Alcindoro in the last half of the second act of "La Bohème", created in Turin, and which, although set in the tales of the poet Murger in Paris in the 1830s, lends itself even better to the modernist
