André-Antoine RAVRIO, pair of Empire period zephyr candelabra, 1805.

Pair of patinated and gilded bronze candelabra depicting a zephyr carrying two torches. The cylindrical base with superb small sconces symbolizing "study" and "fire", the whole on a console chiseled with palmettes. Magnificent bobeches sculpted with anthemions. One is missing (one is also missing on the pair

kept in the national furniture).

This model of zephyr candelabra, made by André Antoine Ravrio (1759-1814), was in the back office of Prince Joachim Murat (1767-1815), on the first floor of the Elysée Palace. The national furniture keeps it under the number
