Description

Boissettes Manufactory (1733 - 1781) Butter dish with floral decoration Hard porcelain with petit feu flower decoration Île de France, late 18th century H. 10; 31; 12.5 cm The butter dish is composed of a body including the receptacle for the butter and a lid. The whole is decorated with a floral decoration whose treatment and style is characteristic of the productions of the Boissettes factory near Melun. The lips have a golden decoration with a tooth motif. The reverse has the mark of an old inventory trace in red. The Boissettes Manufactory First an earthenware factory from 1733, it became a porcelain factory in 1776. Due to lack of profitability, it ceased its activity in 1781. These 5 years have left refined and rare objects for lovers of 18th century porcelain. Condition report: Two visible firing
