Pair of finely carved and molded oak paneled doors from the early 19th century Pair of 2-panel doors The central panels are heavily molded in the Louis XV style The top of the doors is carved with leafy branches The left door has a false frame The 2 doors are arched at the top The lock and its key are from the late 19th century The hinges are complete with their male counterpart The frame is molded and carved in its center with a rosette flower The hinges and pins are in highly decorated solid brass The pins end with a rooster's head like in the 18th century Very rich and deep moldings Pair of very high quality doors Fully pegged Perfect condition h: 178.5 cm total width: 130 cm width of door 1: 60.8 cm width of door 2: 70.2 cm height of pins: 42.8 cm thickness: Dealer
